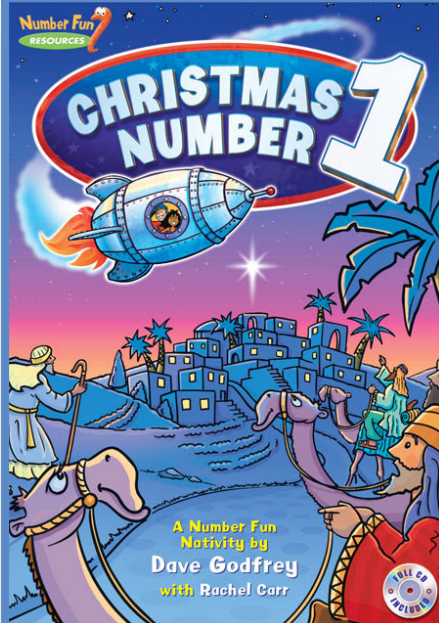
NEW SCHOOL NURSE
