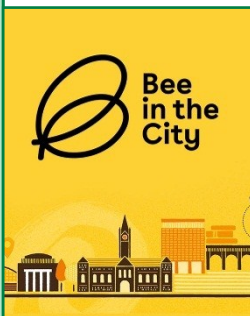
Morning routines
