Subject Specific Vocabulary	
Brasilia	The capital city of Brazil.
Brazil	A large country in South America that is famous for its beaches, carnivals and football.
Capital city	The place where a country's parliament is held.
Carnival	A special event that lasts for four days in Rio de Janeiro.
Country	An area which has a defined border.
Human Feature	Are things that are built by humans.
Mountain	An area of high ground that has steep sloping sides. The highest point is called the summit.
Oceans and Rivers	A river is a large, flowing water body that merges into a sea or an ocean.
Percussion	Instruments that make a sound when they are hit, scraped or rattled. Drums are percussion instruments.
Physical Feature	Are natural features e.g. hills, rivers and seas.
Portuguese	The language spoken in Brazil which originates in Portugal.
River	A river is a large, flowing water body that merges into a sea or an ocean.
Samba	A Brazilian music and dance style that started in Africa.
