Sticky Knowledge

- 1. A settlement is a place where people live and work. A settlement will have some human features and some physical features. Physical features form naturally, like rivers, hills and beaches. Human features are manmade, like churches, train stations and parks.
- 2. A community is made up of the people who live there. A community can change over time. How people shop is one way a community might change. For example, in the past, people shopped at smaller shops. Nowadays, people do their shopping at a supermarket or online.
- 3. A map is a picture or drawing that shows the location of human and physical features. Maps often include symbols, instead of words, to show important features. These can be pictures or letters. A key explains what the map symbols mean.
