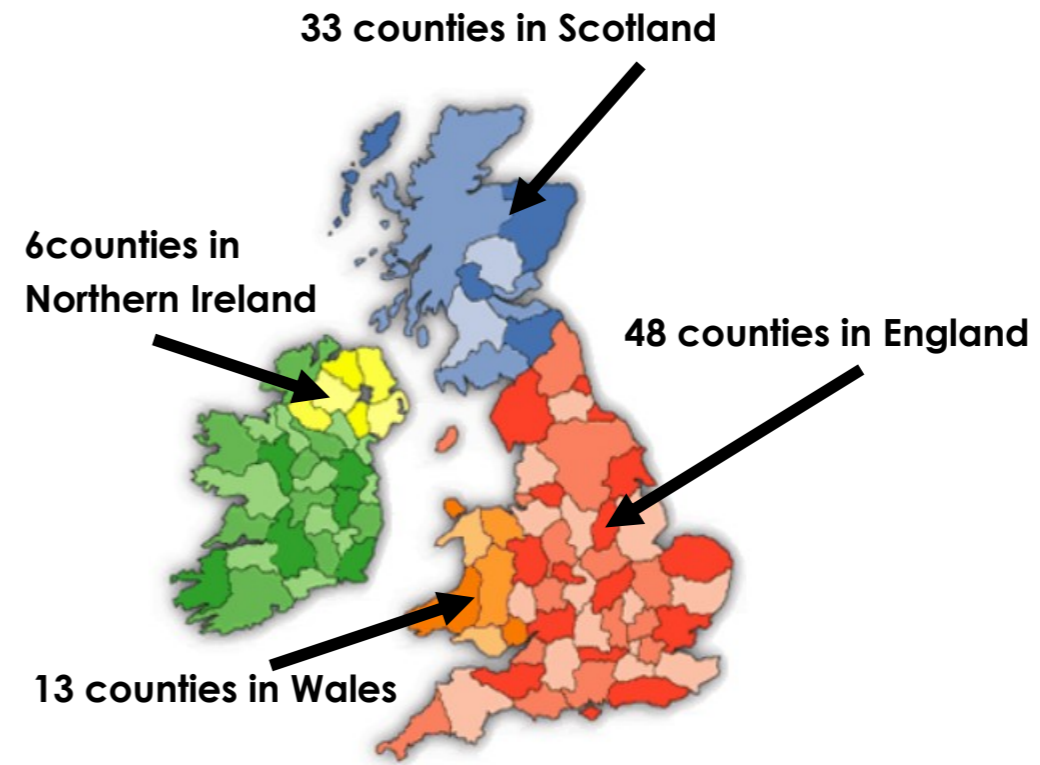
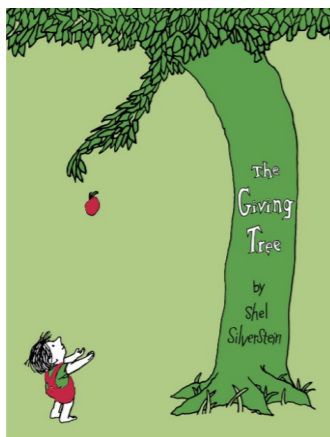

Subject Specific Vocabulary			
Compass	A compass is an instrument used for navigation and orientation that shows direction relative to the magnetic North pole.	Grid reference	Grid references define locations in maps using coordinates. Grid lines on maps define the coordinate system, and are numbered to provide a unique reference to each location on the map.
Fieldwork	The gathering of information about something in a real, natural environment, rather than in a classroom.	Settlement	This is a form of human habitation which ranges from a single dwelling to large city.
Human Geography	The study of people and their communities, cultures, economies, and interactions with the environment.	Physical Geography	The branch of natural science which deals with the study of processes and patterns in the natural environment.
County (ies)	A geographical region of a country used for administrative or other purposes.	Topography	The study of the shape and features of land surfaces.

To know that human geography is the study of people and their interaction in the environment and that physical geography is the study of the natural environment.
