Dear Parents & Carers,

As you will be aware this week has been Sports Week in school. The children have enjoyed access to a wide variety of sport activities including Golf, Volleyball and Tennis. I would like to thank the coaches from Primary Sports and Didsbury Tennis Club for partnering with our school. 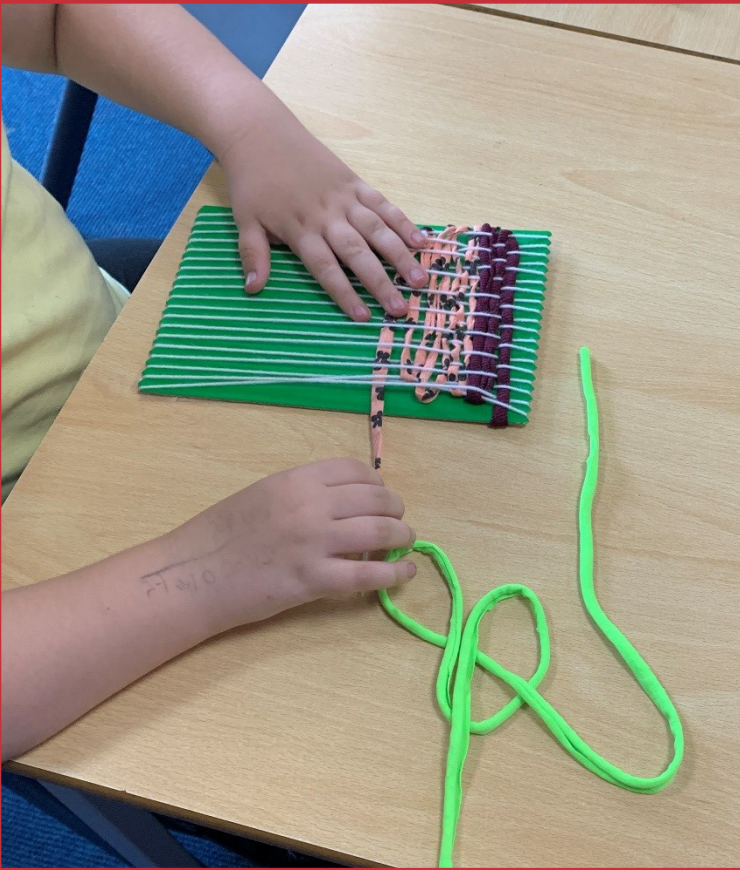

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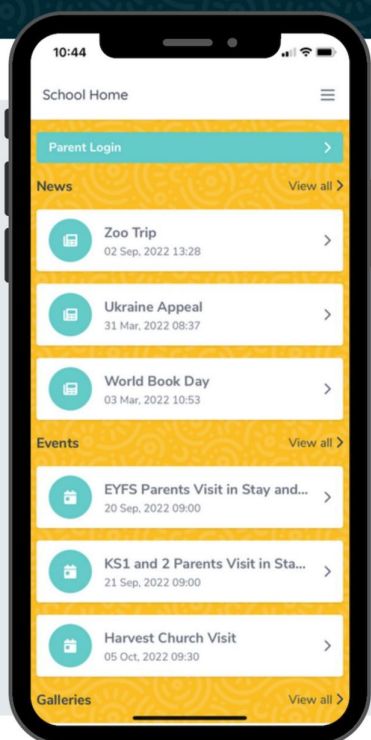
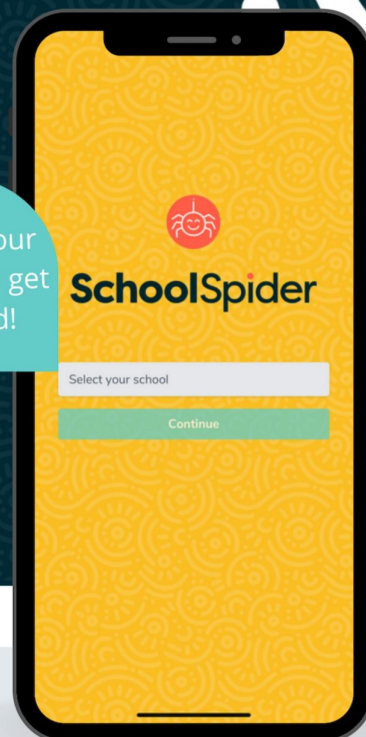

How to get started

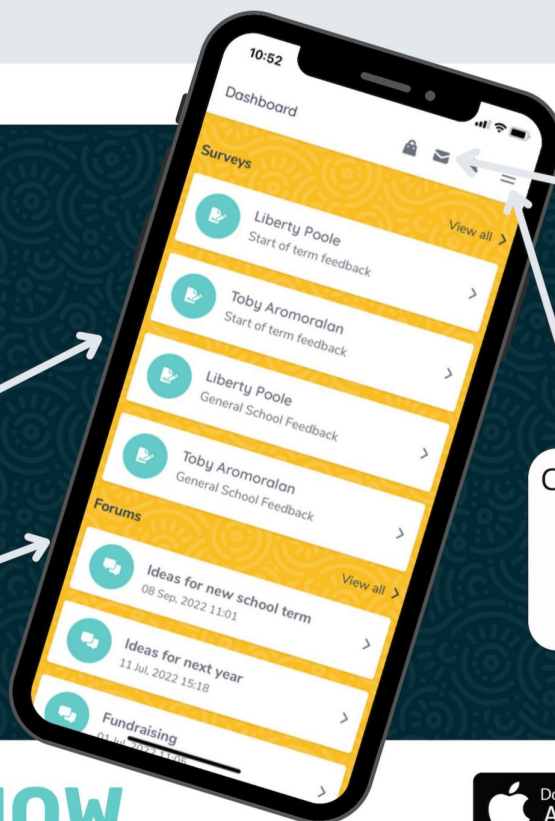
Once you have selected the school, you will see posts from the school website. Click parent dashboard to login or create an account. Create an account by pressing "create account" and enter your email address.
